Dear Customer,

On June 1, 2007 the European chemical policy REACH (Registration, Evaluation and Authorisation of Chemicals) came into force. The intention of this highly complex law is that industrial companies should be directly responsible for investigating their chemical substances for possible dangers to human health and the environment. Manufacturers and importers of chemical substances are required to register the substances and their usage.

In order to maintain compliance with all aspects of REACH, DTI focused its efforts in the following areas:

- Determining the applicability of our products to the REACH regulation
- To ensure that your usage of our products will be registered, if necessary

During our assessment of the applicability of our products to the REACH regulation, we determined that substances contained in our products, classified as “articles” under REACH, will not be subject to the REACH Registration requirement because the amount of substances per article was minute and the substances contained in the “articles” were not intended for release.

According to the updated SVHC list put out by ECHA, there are no substances DTI is currently using listed as an SVHC.
